

Clive Grant studied organ with Alan Wicks at Canterbury Cathedral, and as an undergraduate, was Organ Scholar at the University Church of Great St. Mary's, Cambridge, studying with Peter Hurford and Gerald Gifford. After graduating he continued his postgraduate studies at Cambridge, focusing on organ, harpsichord and piano accompaniment, attending masterclasses in London and Paris. He has given recitals in various Cambridge Colleges, London, Exeter, Chichester and Llandaff Cathedrals, as well as in venues across Europe, including Belgium, Germany, Czech Republic, Italy and France.

For many years he was Head of Music and Expressive Arts at St. Bartholomew's School, Newbury, and is now a part time Associate lecturer in Music Education at Reading University, examining on the BAEd programme, MA and doctoral research programmes. In 2006 he was elected a Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts.

He lives in Somerset with his wife Melanie, and they split their time between their homes in the UK and France.
