# ROY WOODHAMS



**ROY WOODHAMS** was born and brought up in East Kent where he spent much of his working life. He was educated at the Dane Court Grammar School in Broadstairs, the Royal College of Music (RCM) and the University of London Institute of Education. He first studied organ and piano with the late Harold Millsted, then at the RCM he studied organ with the late John Birch, piano with the late John Russell and theory of music with the late Robert Ashfield. Alongside a career in teaching he was Director of Music at St. John's Parish Church in Margate, and was at that time well known throughout south-east England as a recitalist, accompanist and choral conductor.

In 1993, after a period of study at Ripon College, Cuddesdon, Roy was ordained in the Church of England. He has held posts in Kent, Oxfordshire and Hampshire, and is currently Rector of Cranleigh, Surrey. Roy is also a Diocesan Organ Adviser for the Diocese of Oxford, and a consultant to the Royal School of Church Music. As time permits, he tries to continue his musical career as recitalist, accompanist and conductor.

Roy is married to Kate, a primary school teacher, and they have two daughters, Beth who is a PhD student at Leeds and Martha, who, having just graduated as a Choral Scholar at Kings College, London last year, is working as Customer Liaison Manager for a musical instrument auction company in London, alongside building a career as a professional singer. Roy's other hobbies include cooking, walking, railways (though he claims not to own an anorak) and holidays.
