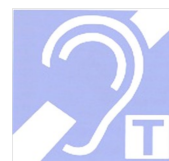

James Paget combined his studies at the London College of Music under Professor Jonathan Melling with the position of Deputy Organist at St. Mary-le-Strand in Westminster.

He has since then received tuition from both Duncan Middleton and Gerard Brooks.

He was appointed Organist of Rannoch School and the three churches within the

glen, and moved to Buckinghamshire in September 2000 where he holds the post of Director of Music and Chapel Organist of Caldicott Preparatory School. After a period playing in the music departments at St. Paul's, Knightsbridge and St. Giles', Stoke Poges, he is now the Organist and Director of Music at St. Mary Magdalene-in-Paddington.

Recent recitals have included Westminster, Southwark and Portsmouth Cathedrals. He is also active as a répétiteur for a number of operatic companies and is currently the Hon. Secretary of the St. Mary Magdalene Music Society.
